The committee aims to have a netbook-like device in each teacher's hands within 5 years (or 2015). Wireless projectors and interactive white boards will also be phased in to each core curricular classroom within this span.

- The Members of the Technology Committee work on a voluntary basis.
- The Head of the Technology Committee must be an adult member of the School.
