1. How and why did YOU choose the service learning topic?
2. Who did you collaborate with (students, teachers, parents, community members, administrators, etc..)?
3. How did you contribute your unique knowledge and skills to the project?
4. What interesting things did you learn as you researched the theme, prepared for the Action, carried out the Action, reflected on the process, and celebrated and demonstrated your learning?
5. How was the project relevant to the things you were learning in school, and how did it improve your learning over all?
6. How did your feelings and perspectives changed as you worked in service learning?
7. How did you develop various skills and improve your weaknesses?
8. How do you think you made a difference to other people?
9. How do you think your work in service learning this year will affect your actions and attitude about the service learning theme in the future?
10. What relationships and personal contacts in the school, local or global community did you cultivate?
